

TAX FILING IS DUE IN APRIL

All Exchange Visitors who were in the USA during 2023 must file a tax return with the IRS. We recommend using <u>Sprintax</u> to assist with filing your taxes. Please note that Turbo Tax is not complaint if you're a non-resident, which most Exchange Visitors are.
